Community Discipleship Rolling Forward Together

We promised you more information about our Community Discipleship (CD) ministry and this newsletter is full of the latest developments, including FAQs to address some of your questions and a map of the CD regions.

The focus of this ministry is to carry out the RHCC Mission—to learn to think and live like Jesus, and to reproduce that in the lives of others—and its purpose is best described by the following:

Community Discipleship Ministry is a commitment of ourselves to Christ and to authentic relationships in small groups while being on mission, together and individually, in our communities to sacrificially serve, share the love of Jesus, and become disciples who make disciples.

We believe this description encompasses three key elements of the CD ministry:

- An individual lifestyle of commitment to Christ, to His mission, and to becoming His disciple
- Connection to a small group built on authentic relationships, in order to make disciples and live on mission together
- Engagement with our community through sacrificial service and by sharing the love of Christ with our families, our neighbors, our co-workers, and others

We hope you were able to hear Pastor Monte Schmidt's message regarding the Community Disciple Ministry on April 25 (if you missed it, view the service video at rollinghills.org/audio-video). Monte explained why we are moving in this direction, its value, its possibilities, and the practical means by which it will be carried out.

Stations for each region are also now available in the Atrium, and we encourage you to stop by your regional station to meet your CD Pastor and to gather more information.

We look forward to your input and involvement in helping reach your community for Christ as we Roll Forward together.

IN TREEHOUSE, YOUR CHILD WILL LEARN ABOUT...

SPROUTS/PRESCHOOL

What a great honor and privilege it is to talk with others about God and to know that God wants to talk with us! Your preschoolers will literally be "all over the map" this month as they encounter Philip talking with the man from Ethiopia and Paul and Silas in jail. They will learn that they can talk to God anytime, anywhere, with anyone. Help them learn their verse from Philippians 4:6 (NLT): "...pray about everything. Tell God what you need and thank him for all he has done."

ELEMENTARY

Adults joke about not praying for patience because we think it gives God permission to put us in all kinds of circumstances to learn it! This month, your kids will learn what patience means from God's perspective—trusting God to give you something later even though you want it now. We will discover the heavy price Bible characters paid when they could not wait for God to act. The May memory verse is Ecclesiastes 7:8 (NIRV): "The end of a matter is better than its beginning.
