Regardless of what month it is, make this the year you get a stronger grasp on the Bible...and let God get a stronger grasp on you!

Nothing else quite compares with systematically and purposefully reading through all of Scripture. More than reading mere “history,” you’ll encounter the fullness of His story. You’ll see a sweeping panorama of the amazing love, sovereignty, majesty, mercy, and eternal wisdom with which God has dealt with humanity over the centuries. You’ll also pick up the pattern of the assorted responses He’s received from men and women down through the ages — ranging from heroic faith to blind disregard to flaming rebellion.


The crowning climax, of course, is the double visitation of God’s Son, once in flesh-and-blood history and once in the promised future. You’ll see this theme woven into the entire fabric of Scripture in countless intricate ways. It will train you to keep your eyes “looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith” (Hebrews 12:2a; ESV).

Although it is only realistic to expect challenges on your reading journey, the deeper you ingest God’s truth, the more your mind will be filled with thoughts of Him. Your entire perspective on life will begin to change. Days will no longer slip by without thoughts of Jesus. You will pray more, pause more, and praise more. You’ll recognize the powerful hand of God at work in and around you. Through it all, you will be changed!

MANY PRODUCTIVE PATHS

Given how large the Bible is and how long it’s been around, there are no shortage of ways to read through the whole Bible. The most important thing is that you do it!

There are a variety of yearly Bible reading plans you might choose. One of the simplest approaches is to read three chapters every day and



five every Sunday. Alternately, you could obtain one of the many One Year Bibles available for purchase from such places as Walk Thru the Bible Ministries (www.walkthru.org). These resources can add rich dimensions to your time in God's Word. Using your own Bible, the plans outlined on the following pages may appeal to you for a number of reasons.


UNITY AND VARIETY EMPHASIZED

In the first plan (adapted from *Discipleship Journal*), each day presents you with four separate places in the Scriptures from which to read. This may initially seem like spreading yourself too thin, but consider its benefits.

To help you keep your focus on our Lord Jesus Christ, one of each day's readings is from one of the four Gospels: Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. The pace here is slow — only a handful of verses on some days — because the content of the record of Christ's life is rich and thought-provoking. Meditate on His words, His actions, and the responses He receives from individuals around Him.¹

Alongside the Gospel readings you'll travel through the rest of the New Testament at a slightly faster pace. Here you will see the exciting development of the early church in Acts, then apply the teachings of Christianity to everyday living through the letters of Paul and the other apostles, and finally explore the future confirmation of God's eternal sovereignty in the book of Revelation.

The daily Old Testament readings are also divided in two parts. The so-called Wisdom books — Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, and Song of Songs — make up the first Old Testament category. Because of their rich devotional nature, the readings here are also at a slower pace. Psalms, the most-read portion of the Old Testament, is presented first in this category, followed by the other four books.

The final Old Testament category includes the law and history books (Genesis through Ezra) and the prophetic writings (Isaiah through Malachi). The pace here is fairly rapid, since these books together make up sixty percent of the Bible's content. Don't read too hastily, however, or you will miss much soul-nourishing truth!

By reading from all four of these categories every day you should be able to better grasp the unity of the Scriptures, as well as enjoy the variety of always seeing four different viewpoints. You'll be surprised how often a certain theme seems to turn up "coincidentally" in more than one of the readings for a particular day.

SUIT YOURSELF

If reading through the entire Bible in one year looms as too large a task, the arrangement of this four-part system allows you to put together the plan that is just right for you. You could try doing only the gospels and the wisdom books this year, for example, and the other books next year. Or, read through only one of the four categories in each of the next four years.

Another idea is to use only one or two of the daily readings for your morning devotional time. Then you can read the rest of the day's portion at noon, before the evening meal, before going to bed, or at some other time you set aside during the day. Enlisting a friend, spouse, or accountability partner is a great way to help you stay on track with whichever approach you choose (e.g., Ecclesiastes 4:9-12).



The “Chronological,” “Puritan,” “Bible Overview,” and “40 Day New Testament” reading plans toward the back of this booklet offer four additional distinct approaches. One of these may better suit your personal goals or schedule. Read the introductory texts before determining which plan is best for you. Whichever plan you choose, there are enough options to keep you exploring the Word for years!

START ANY TIME


These Bible reading plans are designed to make it as easy as possible for you to enter in at any point of the year. The readings are arranged so that, except for some longer books whose readings last for more than one month, you begin each category each month with new books.

Also, since every month in the first schedule includes the same number of daily readings (as is explained below), you can begin the “January” reading in February or any other month. Then you can follow through the year’s scheduled readings in order without any calendar conflicts.

BREATHING ROOM BUILT IN

The first reading program presented here has a feature designed to help you overcome the problem of falling behind schedule, something most of us tend to do when trying to follow a Bible reading plan.

By lengthening the daily readings very slightly, this plan gives you only twenty-five daily portions for each month. With these five or six “free” days per month, you could plan to set aside Sundays and holidays either not to read at all or to catch up on any readings you may have missed in the past week, without the added pressure of new daily assignments for those days. Or, you could plan to finish the month’s readings by the twenty-fifth of every month, and the final days of the month could be used to do your own in-depth study of passages that may have intrigued or challenged you.



why should someone aim to read through the whole Bible in a year?


Isn't that a bit much? Well, here are just a few of the many reasons to explore the Word of God each day:


- Daily reading gives you a “big picture” view of Scripture. Detailed Bible study is like mining for truth far beneath the earth's surface. We desperately need those gems, but we also need the counterbalance of the broad, overall sweep that we only get by reading longer sections regularly. Studying one portion yields marvelous details, but reading by volume with a specific goal in mind gives a better overall perspective on Scripture.

- Daily reading helps prevent doctrinal tangents and sidetracks.

More than 3000 cults in North America represent many voices under the guise of true religion, all clamoring for allegiance. Some false teachings are difficult to discern. Almost all, however, were formed when someone put undue emphasis on a few passages of Scripture, which they typically stripped from their context or otherwise misinterpreted. As the Second Coming of Christ draws near, many false Christs and prophets will try to seduce the people of God (e.g., Mark 13:21–23). The Word of God can give us correct discernment: “If they do not speak according to this word, they have no light of dawn” (Isa 8:20; cf. Acts 17:11; 1 Thess 5:21).

- Daily reading with the Spirit's guidance can keep us from majoring on the minors. Doctrinal issues that too drastically divide believers can be kept in perspective by reviewing the broad issues and events. Familiarity with the whole Word of God by constant and repeated reading helps us recognize when immature or false teachers are tearing a passage out of the larger context of Scripture. Knowing the broad perspective brings precious balance.



- Daily reading helps you (re)familiarize yourself with God's truth. As you read daily, review the previous markings and notes in the margins of your Bible. Not to review every year means the possible loss of important truths, insights, commitments, and vital personal applications, as well as specific direction for life, ministry, counseling, witnessing, relationships, and more. My personal marginal notes have led me back to the steady foundation of absolute truth many times!
 - Daily Bible reading makes difficult passages more clear over time. A well-worn foot path through books like Revelation, Daniel, Ecclesiastes, Hebrews, and Haggai will make those and other "rugged mountains" increasingly familiar and understandable. Eventually you will even become a guide for others. All of this is part of the spiritual growth process toward maturity into Christlikeness (Rom 8:29-30; Eph 4:13-16).
 - Daily Bible reading gives you a moral bath in spiritual truth (e.g., Jas 1:21). It transports you from the secular, the physical, the mundane cares of the day, to the heart of the living God, speaking to your inner being through His cleansing Word (e.g., Eph 5:25-27). How easy it is in the midst of daily routines and constant contact with people to develop unclean thoughts or to be offended by an unloving, thoughtless word in the grocery store! Only God's Word, washing us daily, can restore peace of mind and take away the resentment that naturally builds up. "Great peace have they who love your law, and nothing can make them stumble" (Ps 119:165).
 - Daily Bible reading teaches us critical lessons like the fear of God, obedience to His Word, humility, sacrifice, contentment, love, and much more. That is why God insisted that anyone who became king of Israel should "write for himself on a scroll a copy of this law... It is to be with him, and he is to read it all the days of his life so that he may learn to revere the LORD his God and follow carefully all the words of this law and these decrees and not consider himself better than his brothers and turn from the law to the right or to the left" (Deut 17:18-
- 

20). Everybody is susceptible to pride, the most subtle and tenacious of sins. Like a spiritual cancer, it eats away at our fellowship with God and others. Only as we see ourselves clearly and daily in the mirror of Scripture can we walk humbly before Him and with others in steadfast obedience (e.g., Amos 3:3; Mic 6:8; 1 Pet 5:5-6).

•Daily Bible reading lengthens physical life and improves health. Daily irritations, small and great, create crippling stress. Without a spiritual refuge, accumulated tension can actually shorten physical life. People who neglect daily intake of the Scriptures open themselves to life-shortening tensions. Modern medicine verifies what the Bible has told us for thousands of years: “My son, do not forget my teaching, but keep my commands in your heart, for they will prolong your life many years and bring you prosperity” (Prov 3:1-2). That’s why we’re told: “consider the blameless, observe the upright; there is a future for the man of peace” (Ps 37:37). Indeed, there is!

Chronological Bible Reading Plan

Reading biblical history in the order it actually unfolded can be an enlightening and rewarding experience! It has the unique ability to make the whole picture of redemptive history more clear and compelling. Give it a try to see for yourself.

Rather than listing the readings in the order they occur in the Bible, this plan — adapted from Leslie Flynn and the American Tract Society — is arranged chronologically. The poetic and prophetic books of the Old Testament are inserted in the historical books at about the time in the narrative where they are thought to have been written. Similarly, the New Testament epistles are inserted in the narrative of the book of Acts at the point when they were written. While there is some (usually minor) difference of opinion as to some details, the chronological arrangement presented here is in alignment with the thinking of leading conservative Bible scholars. Again, you can start at any point in the year, checking off the boxes each day to record your progress. Since there are no built in days off for this plan, you may wish to pick some days to double-up to give you a little breather when you need it.

Bible Overview Reading Plan

Many Bible readers get bogged down in some portions of the Old Testament and never complete the entire Bible. Often this is due to not understanding the overall story of redemptive history and how various parts of the Bible fit into the larger story. The following chronological reading plan, adapted from R. C. Sproul's *Knowing Scripture*, does not cover every book in the Bible, but provides the framework that can be built upon for a greater understanding of the whole. You can complete this reading plan in just over ten months by reading one chapter a day.

Puritan Reading Plan

One classic Bible reading approach has helped many believers since the Puritan times explore the whole Bible in exactly 365 days. In addition to its time-tested reliance, its special value is exposing you to different parts of Scriptures each day while providing continuity by causing you to return to the same section on the same day of the week all through the year. As with other non-linear plans, there is a further advantage in that it also helps you see the wonderful unity and remarkable interconnections of various sections of Scripture. For instance, a quotation of a Psalm you read on Sunday may be picked up on Monday in Hebrews. These fortunes are simply astonishing!

- Sunday = Read 5 chapters in Psalms...and then go on to read 5 more chapters each day, continuing with Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, and Song of Solomon
- Monday = Read 3 chapters in Genesis...and then go on to read 5 more chapters each day, continuing with Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy
- Tuesday = Read 4 chapters in Joshua...and then go on to read 5 more chapters each day, continuing with Judges, Ruth, 1-2 Samuel, and 1-2 Kings
- Wednesday = Read 3 chapters in Job...and then go on to read 5 more chapters each day, continuing with 1-2 Chronicles, Ezra, Nehemiah, and Esther
- Thursday = Read 3 chapters in Isaiah... and then go on to read 5 more chapters each day, continuing with Jeremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, Daniel, Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi



- Friday = Read 3 chapters in Mathew....and then go on to the read 5 more chapters each day, continuing with Mark, Luke, John, and Acts
- Saturday = Read 3 chapters in Romans...and then go on to the read 5 more chapters each day, continuing with 1-2 Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1-2 Thessalonians, 1-2 Timothy, Titus, Philemon, Hebrews, James, 1-2 Peter, 1-3 John, Jude, and Revelation.

You'll want to use some marker to help you identify where you have stopped reading in each of the seven sections. Toward the end of the year, you will find that you complete some sections before others, because they are not all exactly the same length.

At that point you can just transfer your marker to one of the longer sections and read from that section on two or more days a week until you are through.

Or perhaps you can revisit a cherished portion of Scripture. Whatever you do, keep Digging

40 Day New Testament Reading Plan

The average life span for a modern American is 25,550 days. How wise it would be if at least once every Christian would set aside 40 of those days to really grasp the “big picture” of the the New Testament (NT). Apparently, God also considers 40 days to be a spiritually significant time period:

- 40 days of rain transformed Noah’s life and the whole course of human history
- 40 days on Mount Sinai transformed Moses and, consequently, millions of others
- 40 days in the Promised Land transformed the spies
- 40 days of challenge by Goliath transformed a little shepherd boy into the mighty King David
- 40 days of strength were miraculously provided to Elijah from a single meal
- 40 days were given to the Ninevites to repent -- they did!
- 40 days was how long the Lord Jesus was empowered in the wilderness before launching His public ministry
- 40 days was the length of time Jesus spent instructing His disciples before His ascension into heaven.

If you set aside 40 days to read the whole NT, I believe God will bless that! This daily tour of the NT averages out to a stretching but manageable 6.5 chapters per day. It may seem like a lot at first, but consider that there are more words in the Sunday edition of the LA Times than in the entire NT. You could certainly read one newspaper in 40 days! But more importantly, reading God’s Word is far more worthwhile and profitable!

Four Primary Purposes of Scripture (2Timothy 3:16)

“All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.” (NIV)

TEACH (What is right?) What is the truth taught here? What does the passage say about God?...about man?...about my relationship with God and/or others?

REBUKE (What is not right?) Am I falling short? If so, how? Where and how is this sin taking place? Is this sin the problem or a symptom of the problem?

CORRECT (How do I get right?) What is the opposite of my sin? What changes do I need to make to get back on track?

TRAIN (How do I stay right?) What do I need to do to stay on track? What are the benefits of doing so and the consequences of not doing so?

May we do just that as we Dig In Daily Into Truth!
