- 42.7% of Internet users view porn
- 20% of men say they view porn at work.
- 53% of Christian men consume pornography.
- Breakdown of male/female visitors to pornography sites: 72% male & 28% female
- 17% of all women struggle with pornography addiction.
- The average age of first Internet exposure to pornography is 11 years old.
- 90% of 8-16-year-olds have viewed porn online (most while doing homework).
