Joyful Noise Brigade is a unique puppet ministry performed by children. The team learns to serve the Lord while serving others. Favorite places to minister include the Oregon State Penitentiary, youth programs in North Portland, retirement homes, migrant camps, and Shriner's Children's Hospital.

The team is comprised of children in Grades 5 & 6. Students in grades 7-12 are encouraged to apply, but will be accepted on a need-basis only. Puppets are our primary ministry, though other creative performing arts are taught and used.

Children who become part of Joyful Noise must be committed to the team. Being committed means: promptness, minimal excused absences, positive attitudes, appropriate behavior, and a willingness to serve. Parents are encouraged to participate and invited to our performances.

There is a registration cost of \$35 which pays for expenses and uniforms. We don't want to exclude anyone because of finances. Other costs may be incurred for trips we take.
