WHAT IS YOUR POTENTIAL?

Ever wonder what you would see if God allowed a glimpse of what your life would look like if you fully trusted Him? What kind of influence would you have? What would the depth of your experience with God and His heart be?

WHAT HOLDS US BACK?

Starting March 13, we will begin a new Sunday morning teaching focus called Unleashed. We hope to bring some of the things that tie us down out in the open so we can find freedom from them and experience more of our redemptive potential.

UNLEASHED is birthed out of the season of Lent, which is the 40-day period that starts on Ash Wednesday and ends on Easter. Lent is traditionally a time of penitence and self-examination for all Christians. In some ways, it is meant to reflect the 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness, where He prayed and was tempted prior to beginning His public ministry that would eventually lead to the Cross.

UNLEASHED will be a time for us to reflect, repent, and find freedom from areas and habits in our lives that have become self-serving or where our perspective has become myopic. Together, we will seek to be unleashed from Safety, Isolation, Distractions, Mediocrity, Discouragement, and Non-essentials; and, through the empowering of God's Spirit, to break free from the old ways and experience the joy of life that comes from following Jesus.
