A Parent's Attitude Toward the Bible

- ~Read the Word of God daily, and ask God to make it precious to you.
- ~Your child will learn that the Bible is special by seeing how often you read it, talk about it, and relate it to your life.
- ~Ask the Lord for specific wisdom on how to begin training your child.

"Bible Time"

- ~Set aside a special time for Bible reading with your child - a close, intimate, undisturbed time.
- ~Make it fun and keep it short, rather than a time to be endured.
- ~Help your child apply Bible truths at his or her level.

Monthly Memory Verse:

Everything in the scriptures is God's word.

Listen to God:

READ II Timothy to your child. The Bible is God's word and the Bible is TRUE. Pick stories that you can **READ** from the Bible and remind your child that the Bible is God's Word and it is true.

PRAY together on how your family can live and think like Jesus.

WALK through the Bible with your child. Your family can make a map of the books of the Bible or draw pictures for each book of the Bible as you learn all 66 books.
